QUESTIONS AND REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION

Requirement 10 - Archaeology

I note the submission of Historic England for deadline 6, and the Applicant's response to that submission at deadline 7.

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council are asked to confirm whether or not they are content with the wording proposed by Historic England, and the function of approving the Written Scheme of Investigation.

The Marine Management Organisation and the Environment Agency are asked to confirm whether or not they are content with the wording proposed by Historic England, particularly as it relates to schemes for the monitoring of dredging works which would otherwise generally be governed by the conditions in the Deemed Marine Licence rather than by requirements. *The applicant* may also wish to comment further on this point.

Draft Development Consent Order

York Potash Limited is asked to submit:

- Their final proposed Draft DCO, including their final proposed drafting of Schedules 9 and 10 representing the outcome of any discussions between themselves and each of the parties proposed to have the benefit of the provisions within those schedules.
