Dear Laura-Beth,

Thank you for this email. I apologise for the delay in replying to you.

The Examining Authority has invited interested parties to respond to the questions as published; my interpretation of them can only be advice. However, I hope the below is helpful:

- Your first point is noted; a plan as described is not an appendix to the CEMP. I suggest that you respond to ES 1.1 by either directing the ExA to or supplying a plan to include the application site boundary (including all temporary works) and with annotations for all road names and crossings of other highways cited in the Environmental Statement.
- I am not aware of anything that you have not seen. I suggest that in response to HWF1.2 in you respond to the identification of the issue by the Environment Agency.
- As you know, all interested parties are invited to respond to questions, even if they are not directed to them; but I can see that a response from Stockton on Tees to question CA 1.8 would be helpful for the reasons you suggest.

I emphasize again that this is my interpretation of the ExA's questions. If we can be of any other assistance, please do contact me.

Hi Rob

We wanted to clarify a few of points in the first questions if possible:

1. ES 1.1 refers to Appendix A of the CEMP but the CEMP does not have any appendices or figures included with it. We are unsure which plan needs revising as requested in that question. Please could you confirm?
2. HWF 1.2 states at 1.2.2 that "the Environment Agency has sought resolution of specific matters in relation to flood risk and in relation to the CEMP in its Relevant Representation" – the RR we have seen on the website identifies flood risk as an important issue but doesn't elaborate – we just wanted to check whether there was any further correspondence with the representation that we may not have seen?
3. CA 1.8 is directed at a number of bodies including Hartlepool Borough Council – I think this should be Stockton on Tees Borough Council, since the Order land doesn't fall within Hartlepool's area?
