We have been made aware by the owners of the CATS Pipeline System about their concerns regarding one of the alternative routes being considered for the conveyor system associated with the proposed York Potash development. The CATS System makes an important contribution to the security of gas supplies to the UK and also provides considerable economic benefits as a result of both offshore and onshore activity. I am not sufficiently aware of the planning process to know whether there is a role for Government Departments to make representations, and I understand that the process is at an advanced stage in any case. However, I would be very grateful if you could outline the expected forward plan and overall approval process for the development consent order, so that we can consider when/how we should make our views known.
