

Dear Sally Bunce,

Thank you for your consultation response regarding MLA/2020/00506 Variation 2.

The MMO license and regulate marine activities in the seas around England so that they're carried out in a sustainable way that do not impact upon the environment, public health and other legitimate uses of the sea.

We have also consulted with several of our primary advisors including the Environment Agency, Inshore Fisheries and Conservation Authority, local Marine Management Organisation colleagues, Maritime and Coastguard Agency, Trinity House, Natural England, Teesport and Centre for Environment Fisheries and Aquaculture Science (Cefas).

Cefas have advised that no additional sampling is required. The applicant does not propose the use of a cofferdam and the MMO is not obliged to request this. Installation of a cofferdam would require piling which is not consented under this marine licence.

The MMO will consider all consultation responses to aid our decision on whether to grant a licence for this application or not.

Any responses received can be used to secure conditions upon any licence.
