### Condition(s) to be attached to any grant of planning permission:

Conditions to address Highways Act Section 175B to be confirmed,

#### Reason(s) for the recommendation above:

To ensure that the **A19**, **A66**, **A174** and **A1053** trunk roads continue to serve their purpose as part of a national system of routes for through traffic in accordance with Section 10(2) of the Highways Act 1980 by minimising disruption on the trunk road network and in the interests of road safety.

The recommendation shall be maintained until **17 March 2021** or until sufficient information has been received to enable Highways England to reach an alternative view at which point a further notice will be issued.

HIGHWAYS ENGLAND has been appointed by the Secretary of State for Transport as strategic highway company under the provisions of the Infrastructure Act 2015 and is the highway authority, traffic authority and street authority for the Strategic Road Network (SRN).
