Beyond this, I have the following informative comments:

Non-Environment Agency lead priority species and habitat – Advice to LPA/applicant

We advise that the applicant bear in mind the potential for species such as toad or hedgehog to be present which are listed as a Species of Principle Importance in England (section 41) under the Natural Environment and Rural Communities (NERC) Act 2006.

We strongly recommend that this is taken into account. Rubble and wood/brash piles may shelter such species and we advise these are removed by hand where possible.
