



1.0 Introduction


This Design & Access Statement has been prepared by Ryder in support of an full application for the LM Wind Plant situated on Land at South Tees, Redcar – The proposed site is located approximately 6km to the west of Redcar and approximately 8km from the east of Middlesbrough. The site is bound by the River Tees to the North West of the site with two existing access points located on Tees Dock Road.

The are of land requiring full planning is 2.97 HA as highlighted on the plan below:
