With reference to the above planning application, I would confirm that I have assessed the following environmental impacts which are relevant to the development and would comment as follows:


I note that a piling risk assessment has been submitted in support of discharge of partial discharge of condition 21 of outline planning permission R/2020/0357/OOM.

Please note that this discharge condition solely relates to the red line boundary set out in proportion to the SEAH site for R/2022/0343/ESM (figure 1 below), and not as shown on Clarkebond drawing (figure 2 below)


