To whom it may concern,

We are writing you this letter to make you aware that Green Lithium Refining Limited will be carrying out a Public Consultation Event relating to our proposed development of a Merchant Lithium Refinery (*'the lithium refinery'* or *'the project'*) on PD Ports land adjacent to Kinkerdale Road, Middlesbrough , TS6 6UD.

The location and boundary of the project is provided below.



The lithium refinery is currently in the pre-development stage with the intention of making an Outline Planning Application during Qtr 1 2023.

The development involves the construction and development of a low carbon lithium refinery and associated dockside reception, handling, storage and manufacturing activities for the

production of approximately 50,000 tonnes per annum of high purity lithium hydroxide monohydrate and associated by-products.

This project meets the definition of a Schedule 1 development as defined by the Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 and therefore will be subject to a detailed planning application and be accompanied by an Environmental Statement.

The applicant has prepared an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) that assesses the impacts of both the construction and operation of the development to an agreed scope that has been confirmed following engagement and consultation with the Planning Authority and the relevant public bodies.

Green Lithium intend to carry out an online public consultation event which will include an overview of the project, conclusions of the Environmental Statement and include the Social and Economic benefits.
