Dear Mr Mayor

I am writing you this letter to make you aware of Green Lithium's plans regarding the proposed construction of Europe's first large-scale lithium refinery plant in Teesside. This project is currently at a pre-planning stage, with the intention of submitting an outline planning application to Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council's planning team before the end of Quarter 1 2023.

The project will bring an estimated £600M of new capital investment into the area, will become a major local employer, will be part of a critical raw materials supply chain for the emerging lithium battery / Electric Vehicles (EV) market and hence be a key regional green infrastructure development.

We intend our development to be highly sustainable and be an exemplar development within the sector.

The project involves the construction and development of a low carbon lithium refinery and associated dockside reception, handling, storage and manufacturing activities for the production of approximately 50,000 tonnes per annum of high purity lithium hydroxide monohydrate and associated by-products.
